Amendments to the Official Community Plan

### Bylaw #09-18 Official Community Plan Amendment #5 Bylaw

Bylaw #09-18 has received first reading to amend the Official Community Plan Bylaw as follows:

- 1) Designation of Lots 8,9,10, Block K, Ladue Estate is amended from CC - Core Commercial to PI-Public Use as shown on MM Map OCP09-18A that is appended to this bylaw as Appendix A and forms a part of this bylaw to allow for an addition to an existing public education facility.
- 2) Destination of Lots 1 & 2, Block 16, Government Reserve Addition and a portion of Parcel U (Rem), Government Reserve Addition that extends along Fifth Avenue to a point 150 ft. (45.5m) from Turner Street and along Turner Street to a point 250 ft. (75.8m) from Fifth Avenue is amended from PI - Public Use to RT - Single/Multiple Transition as shown on MM Map OCP09-18B to allow for a multiple family residence.

Amendments to Zoning Bylaw

### Bylaw #09-19 Zoning and Heritage Management Amendment #2

Bylaw #09-19 received first reading to amend the Zoning Bylaw as follows to allow for a new health service facility, skateboard park, an addition to an existing public education facility and a new multiple family residence:

- 1) Part IV. Zoning Districts, PD - Public Use. (2) Permitted Uses is hereby amended to add Health Services.
- 2) Part IV. Zoning Districts. OS - Open Space (2) Discretionary Uses is hereby amended to add Outdoor Participant Recreation Services.
- 3) Zoning of Lots 8,9,10, Block K, Ladue Estate is amended from CC - Core Commercial to PD - Public Use as shown on MM Map OCP09-19A that is appended to this bylaw as Appendix A and forms a part of this bylaw.
- 4) Zoning of Lots 1 & 2, Government Reserve Addition and a portion of Parcel U (Rem), Government Reserve Addition that extends along Fifth Avenue to a point 150 ft. (45.5m) from Turner Street and along Turner Street to a point 250 ft. (75.8) from Fifth Avenue is amended from PI - Public Use and RM - Multiple Family Residential to RM - Multiple Family Residential solely as shown on MM - Map OCP09-19B that is appended to this bylaw as Appendix B. and forms a part of this bylaw.
